The following is the decision taken in the 72nd Academic Council meeting held on 10th September 2022:

The Academic Council **approved** the following:

#### 7.1 Introduction of new open elective from academic year 2022-23 onwards

'Nutrition and Wellness' by the department of Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics, MCHP, Manipal

#### 7.2 Agenda related to admissions

- Increase in seat matrix for BASLP in MCHP, Manipal from 25 to 40, for five academic sessions (2022 -23 to 2026-27) as per approval from RCI

- Eligibility for PG with work experience for M.Sc. (RRTDT) & M.Sc. (PFT)

A minimum of 45% as eligibility percentage for PG admission to be given to students having a board approved diploma in RRTDT & PFT. They should have an additional undergraduate degree with biological science background and a minimum 5 years of work experience in the respective domain. The selection will be based on respective departmental test and interview as applicable

#### 7.3. Agenda related to Academics

- a. Inclusion of General Psychology (2 credit) course for B.Sc. (Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics) program in IV semester from batch 2022-23 onwards. Credit readjustment from 6 to 4 credit in CND 2261 and total hour distribution in view of inclusion of general psychology paper

- b. Inclusion of program electives for the following PG programs during IV semester from 2022-23 admission onwards

- M.Sc. (Perfusion Technology)
- MPT (Community Physiotherapy)
- M.Sc. (Speech Language Pathology)
- M.Sc. (Audiology)
- MSc (Respiratory therapy- Adult respiratory care)

- c. Inclusion of program electives for the following PG programs during IV semester from 2021-22 admission onwards

- MSc (Respiratory Therapy – Neonatal & Pediatric respiratory care)



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- M.Sc. (Medical Imaging Technology) Credit readjustments in semester to accommodate program elective
  - d. BASLP – II semester Clinical Psychology and Biostatistics & Research Methodology end semester examination to be conducted for 50 marks and normalized to 75
  - e. BSc Anaesthesia and Operation Theatre Technology - AOT3231 Clinical-IV Course will have an End Semester Examination.
  - f. Change in nomenclature of courses – MSc (Health Information Management) and MSc (Health Informatics)
    - i. Health Information Management (HIM 5202) to “Advanced Health Information Management”
    - ii. Professional Competency in HIM (HIM 6201) to Professional Practices in HIM
    - iii. Professional Competency in Health Informatics (HIT 6201) to Professional Practices in HIT
  - g. Minor corrections in UG PG OBE curriculum
- 7.4 Inclusion of teaching hospital name in mark sheet for B.Sc. (Radiotherapy Technology) and M.Sc. (Medical Radiation Physics) as per AERB Regulation requirements
- 7.5 Award of degree for Integrated program B.Sc. (Health Information Management) MS (Health Informatics) in case if a student fails to go to IUPUI for last two semesters
- a. The candidate needs to complete two more years including 01 year of internship and the 01 year of the remaining master program. After satisfactory completion of the program, MAHE will award both B.Sc. (Health Information Management) and M.Sc. (Health Informatics) degrees to the candidate
  - b. If candidate wishes to exit with Bachelor degree, then candidate needs to complete 01 year of internship and MAHE will award the B.Sc. (Health Information Management) degree to the candidate
  - c. This will be applicable to both the existing students who joined the program and will be considered for the future batch of students

The Academic Council **approved** the following:

- Implementation of **OBE curriculum for Master of Library and Information Science (M.Lib.I.Sc)** Programme based on revised syllabus from the academic year 2022-23 onwards
- Reduction in the total credits from 90 to 80 from the academic year 2022-23 as per the Academic Semester Credit System Guidelines of MAHE
- **Introduction of one open elective based on online courses through MOOC (ePG Pathshala/Swayam)** per semester (semester I-III) with 3 credits each from the academic year 2022-23
- Introduction of internship of 6-8 weeks duration and (2 credits) and project work with 10 credits in the final (fourth) semester from the academic year 2022-23
- Reduction in the minimum pass marks from 45% to 40% from the academic year 2022-23
