The Academic Council approved the following:

- 7.1 Introduction of the following new programs from the academic year 2022-23
- M.Sc. (Anaesthesia & Operation Theatre Technology)
- M.Sc. (Emergency Medical Technology)
- B.Sc. (Physician Assistant)
- Bachelor in Prosthetics and Orthotics
- 7.2 Introduction of new open electives
  - · 'Healthy Kidney for better living' by the department of RRTDT, MCHP, Manipal
  - 'Disability Perspectives: An Overview' by the department of Occupational Therapy, MCHP, Manipal
- 7.3 Agenda related to admissions
- Speech & Hearing revised eligibility criteria (as per RCI regulations) from the academic year 2021-22 onwards
  - For M.Sc. (Audiology) and M.Sc. (Speech Language Pathology)
    - Candidates with BASLP/BSc (Speech & Hearing) from any university/institute recognized by RCI with a minimum of 55% aggregate marks
    - No age bar

For Bachelor in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology

- Passed 10+2/equivalent examination from a recognized board with 50% aggregate marks
- Should have studied Physics & Chemistry with any one of the subjects (Biology, Mathematics, Computer Science, Statistics, Psychology, Electronics)
- No age bar
- Lateral entry to 2nd year BPT program for Malaysian Diploma holders
  - > Should have completed 3 years of diploma from Malaysia (Credits: 108)
  - Number of seats: 20% of total capacity
- 7.4 Minor Correction in UG/PG curriculum (codes, framework and contents)
  - PG first digit course Code change from level 6 & 7 to Level 5 & 6
  - Curriculum corrections documented and added as an addendum in existing curriculum copies for each program
- 7.5 Change in nomenclature of certificate courses offered in MCHP, Manipal, KMC, Mangaluru and Manipal Hospital, Bengaluru from the academic year 2021-22 onwards
  - Prefixed as "Basic" or "Advanced" based on program duration rather than as "diploma"
- 7.6 Discontinuation of some certificate courses offered in MCHP, Manipal from the academic year 2021-22 onwards

- i. In M.Sc. (Emergency Medical Technology) program, EMT 5201 course, the following may be
  - · Organisms should be classified based on the type of outbreaks they cause
  - · Precautions to be taken by the technologists, based on the type of pathogen involved
- ii. In B.Sc. (Physician Assistant) program:
  - Scope of practice has to be clearly defined in the curriculum
  - Curriculum must incorporate everything mentioned in the national council guidelines for Physician Assistant program
- iii. In M.Sc. (Emergency Medical Technology) and M.Sc. (Anaesthesia & Operation Theatre Technology)
  - Scope of practice has to be clearly defined in the curriculum
  - Any clinical service which can be independently performed by the technologist, as mentioned in the national council guidelines, must be incorporated in the curriculum
