



- 5. The Registrar, Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore shall be responsible for submission of Statements of Expenditure (SoEs), Utilization Certificates (UCs), Assets Acquired Certificates (AACs), Manpower Due Drawn Statements (MDDSs), in prescribed DBT formats to DBT in respect of grants released in this project from time to time.
- 6. - 9. A transparent procurement procedure in line with the provisions of General Financial Rules 2017 will be followed by Grantee organization(s) while procuring capital assets sanctioned for the mentioned project and a certificate to this effect will be submitted by the Grantee organization(s) immediately on receipt of the grant.
- 10. DBT reserves sole rights on the assets created out of grants, Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of government grants (except those declared as obsolete and unserviceable or condemned in accordance with the procedure laid down in GFR 2017), shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of DBT.
