5. **The Registrar, Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore** shall be responsible for submission of Statements of Expenditure (SoEs), Utilization Certificates (UCs), Assets Acquired Certificates (AACs), Manpower Due Drawn Statements (MDDSs), in prescribed DBT formats to DBT in respect of grants released in this project from time to time.
6.
