- To start Fellowship training program in Critical care Learning and Ultrasound Evaluation. (The Fellowship program will be point of contact based incorporating online training, hands-on workshop, theory examination and practical examination and not a full-time residency program).

#### Objectives:

- 1) Develop a structured training program for multi-organ POCUS-based evaluation in the critically ill.
- 2) Make this a centre of National importance in critical care ultrasound training among professionals in intensive care, emergency medicine, anaesthesia and medicine – attract MD/ DM students who will also receive this additional fellowship from here.

- 3) Establish partnerships with service providers, such as Government medical officers, law enforcement agencies, child welfare committee, and other local organizations, to facilitate comprehensive and coordinated medicolegal care for survivors.
