**Congratulations!** We are pleased to inform you that you have been awarded a **\$2,250.00 USD** International Travel Scholarship from the American Academy for Cerebral Palsy and Developmental Medicine (AACPDM) to attend the 79th Annual Meeting in New Orleans, Louisiana, from October 15th-18th, 2025. Please see the details of the scholarship below:

**Complimentary Registration**

As a scholarship recipient, you will receive complimentary full meeting registration (Wednesday-Saturday) to attend the meeting. All other optional courses and events (pre-course, networking dinners, etc.) are your individual responsibility. Please note that you must register yourself for the meeting in order to receive the complimentary registration.

Registration for the Annual Meeting will open in mid-May. **You must first notify AACPDM of your intent to accept the scholarship and attend the 79th Annual Meeting** by emailing [clofald@aacpdm.org](mailto:clofald@aacpdm.org) no later than **Friday, June 20, 2025**.

After notifying AACPDM of your intent to accept the scholarship, you must register online with the following code **by July 11, 2025: ORLEANS25**  
*Please note this is a non-transferable code.*

**Lodging, Transportation, Meals, and Airfare**

Air / ground transportation, lodging accommodations and meals will be reimbursed up to the full amount of the scholarship with scanned copies of the original receipts. The host hotel information will be available on the AACPDM website once registration opens. You must arrange these details on your own, and lodging may be booked at the host hotel or through third party booking sites (Airbnb, VRBO, etc.). Lodging will only be reimbursed up to the approved AACPDM hotel block rate per date.

**Passports / Visas**

**Expectations of Scholarship Recipients**

1. Fully immerse in the program.
2. Respond to all Academy and International Affairs Committee Communications as requested, in a timely manner.
3. Be prepared to discuss health care provision within your own country and facility, so we may also learn from you.
4. Maintain communication with your International Affairs host before and during the meeting.
5. Complete a survey questionnaire within two months of returning home, as well as a follow-up survey one (1) year after, including a report regarding the outcome of goal/s set after attending the meeting.
